## Hongkong



I was given the privilege to come to Hongkong for two days and observe in KLC Hongkong. This church was founded by Ps. Apollo Quiboloy, from Davao City, Philippines. His theology is very controversial as he claims to be the "Jesus Christ of this age" and he calls himself as the "Appointed son". His theology is interesting but dangerous. I may try to write a paper about him and his theology in my further studies. Let's pray for our brethren there for God's protection against dangerous doctrines. God is not finished with anyone yet. There's no room for condemnation of people, but only questions and doubts for false teachings.



My visit to Myanmar was very interesting and memorable. I have a growing burden for the kids there especially for the child laborers. I actually had an initial research about child laborers ministry in my Cultural Anthropology class. I wish to apply what I have researched in the future either here in the Philippines or in Myanmar. I am planning to have a three-month language learning in Yangon or Lashio, Myanmar this year or in 2016. Please pray for this pursuit with me. I am also raising funds for this goal. On the other hand, the outreaches in Guinobatan, Albay is continuous. My main ministry in this place is called "Menschville".
